

PROPOSED BUDGET HEARING FOR 2010
TOWN OF NEWTON
DECEMBER 7, 2009

A public budget hearing meeting for the Town of Newton proposed budget for 2010 was held at the Newton Town Hall, 6532 Carstens Lake Road, Manitowoc, WI at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, December 7, 2009.

Present: Kevin Behnke, Chairman; John H. Karbon, Jr., Supervisor; Donald Schuette, Supervisor; Barbara Pankratz, Clerk , Milton Behringer, Gary Truettner and Charlie Bauer.

The budget hearing meeting was opened by Chairman Behnke. The same was published in the Herald-Times-Reporter, posted on the web-site for the Town of Newton and also posted in the official posting places for the Town of Newton. Chairman Behnke opened the public hearing for comments and questions from the public. Gary Truettner had questions about the contingency fund, FDIC coverage on Town of Newton money and Plan Commission wages. Kevin answered the questions posed. Mr. Truettner also expressed the desire for the Town Board to set aside money to create a Heritage Foundation for Town of Newton history which Chairman Behnke stated the Board would consider.

Gary Truettner made a motion to approve the 2010 Highway expenditures. Milton Behringer seconded the motion which carried.

Charlie Bauer made a motion to approve the 2010 levy. Gary Truettner made a motion to second this motion which carried.

A motion was made by Gary Truettner to adopt the Proposed Budget as presented for the Town of Newton for 2010. Said motion was seconded by Milton Behringer and carried.

There being no further agenda items to come before the meeting motion to adjourn was made by Kevin Behnke and seconded by Donald Schuette . Motion carried.
