

Section 4. Penalties. Any person who obliterates, removes, damages, destroys, fails to properly locate or fails to timely replace an address marker or otherwise violates this Ordinance shall forfeit not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense plus any penalty or other assessments imposed by statute and the cost of prosecution. Each day a violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 5. Injunctive Relief. In addition to all other remedies available, the Town Board of Newton may authorize the commencement of appropriate action or proceeding to prohibit the owner, resident, agent or occupant of the real estate within the Town of Newton from removing, destroying, obliterating or damaging an address marker in violation of this ordinance.

Section 6. Severability. If any section clause, provision or portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
