

6. Except as otherwise provided, any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction of such violation, be subject to a penalty which shall be as follows:

(a) First Offense. Documented warning by Town Official.

(b) Second Offense. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit the sum of \$25.00, together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 30 days.

(b) Third and Continued Offense. Any person found guilty of violating any ordinance or part of an ordinance of this code who has previously been convicted of a violation of the same ordinance shall pay \$100.00 for the third offense and double the amount every time thereafter. Together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 90 days.

7. No burning in the Town Dump by unauthorized person or persons.

This order becomes effective upon the posting of Special Fire Warning Notices fp-25 and shall continue in effect.
