

TOWN OF NEWTON BOARD MEETING (ROUGH DRAFT)
NOVEMBER 10, 2021

The Town Board meeting of the Town of Newton was held on Wednesday, November 10, 2021 at the Newton Town Hall, 6532 Carstens Lake Road, Manitowoc, WI 54220 at 6:00 pm. Notices have been posted on the official posting places as well as on the Town of Newton website.

Chairman Denise Thomas indicated that the proposed budget meeting which was to be held previous to this meeting was rescheduled for 1:00 pm on Friday, November 26, 2021 pursuant to posted notices.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Denise Thomas. Present: Denise Thomas, Chairman; Kevin Behnke, Supervisor #1; Mark Knorr, Supervisor #2; Barbara Pankratz, Clerk; Dave Mueller, Road Superintendent/Law Enforcement Officer; Larry Stock, Charlie Bauer, Ed Downing, Kelly Christiansen and Roger Busse. Paulette Vogt, Treasurer was excused.

All those present joined in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance. Mark Knorr made a motion to approve the agenda. Said motion was seconded by Kevin Behnke and passed.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved by motion made by Kevin Behnke and seconded by Denise Thomas. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report was submitted to the Board previous to the meeting and approved by motion made by Mark Knorr and seconded by Kevin Behnke. Motion carried.

The next item on the agenda was public in-put. There being none said agenda item was closed.

Dave Mueller, Road Supervisor gave a report on culverts and also informed the Board that there is a problem with the overhanging sheets on the entire upper and lower roofs of the Town Hall building. He submitted a proposal from A.C.E. Building Service to fix the roofs for a total quote of \$5,478.00. Kevin Behnke made a motion to accept said bid which motion was seconded by Denise Thomas.

Dave Mueller, Law Enforcement officer, made a report on dog incidents.

Mike Slattery, Zoning Administrator submitted his report to the Board previous to the meeting. There were no questions or comments about his report.

Kevin Behnke, Supervisor #1 indicated that seventy-five units of freon were collected at the Recycling Center and made a motion that per our agreement with the person in charge of the collection, payment of \$5.00 per unit or \$375. will be sent to him. Denise Thomas seconded the motion which carried. It was also noted that the town will have to find someone else to take care of the freon and electronic collections.

Chairman Thomas indicated that the Board should decide what road the Town should do for the TRIP Program and it was decided that it would be Brunner Road.

Chairman Thomas will contact Pest Control to take care of a fly issue in the Town Hall. She will also order the stickers for the tax bills.

Motion was made by Kevin Behnke to accept and pay the bills. Motion was seconded by Mark Knorr and passed.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Kevin Behnke made a motion to adjourn the town board meeting until December 8, 2021. Mark Knorr seconded the motion which carried. Meeting adjourned.
