

PROPOSED BUDGET MEETING – ROUGH DRAFT
NOVEMBER 26, 2021

Denise Thomas, Chairman called the proposed 2022 budget meeting to order at 1:00 pm on Friday, November 26, 2021 pursuant to Sec. 60.12(1)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes. Present: Denise Thomas, Chairman, Kevin Behnke; Supervisor, Mark Knorr, Supervisor; Barbara Pankratz, Clerk; Charlie Bauer, Ed Downing and Roger Busse. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

The notice of said meeting has been published in the Herald-Times Reporter and posted on the official posting places in the Town of Newton. An affidavit indicating that such postings took place is on file with the clerk.

After the meeting was called to order Chairman Thomas stated that the budget was similar to the one last year. Chairman Thomas indicated we are adding money to the Committed Fund for the Newton fire truck as well as funds designated for roads and it was felt that the way the funds were allocated was very responsible. Chairman Thomas asked those present if there were any questions about the budget. Roger Busse asked about the levy limit and was told that it was the same as last year. Charlie Bauer questioned about the rising cost for the town shop and was told that it was generated because of necessary items purchased for the shop. Roger Busse also inquired if any raises were given to any employees and was told what they were.

Chairman Thomas closed the public hearing and called the meeting to order for the electors of the Town of Newton pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 16.12(1)(b) for the proposed 2022 budget for the Town of Newton. The notice was published in the Herald-Times-Reporter timely, posted on two posting places in the Town of Newton as well as inserted

on the official web site of the Town of Newton. An affidavit is on file with the clerk.

Ed Downing made a motion to approve and adopt the Town of Newton 2022 budget and levy. Said motion was seconded by Charlie Bauer and was unanimously approved by the electors.

Motion to approve and adopt the 2022 budget by the Town Board of Newton was made by Supervisor Kevin Behnke and seconded by Supervisor Mark Knorr. Motion passed.

Supervisor Kevin Behnke made a motion to adjourn the special meeting for approval of the 2022 budget for the Town of Newton. Supervisor Mark Knorr seconded the motion which carried.
