## TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

When the Town of Newton deems it necessary, the Town may post "No Parking" signs to regulate traffic on Town roads for the safety and well-being of all.

The Town Board of the Town of Newton has the specific statutory authority, powers and duties, pursuant to the specific statutory sections noted in this Ordinance and/or by its adoption of village powers under Sec. 60.10, (1988-1989) Wis. Stats., to regulate, control, prevent and enforce against in the Town of Newton certain uses, activities, businesses and operations by persons that may affect the traffic in the Town of Newton.

The Town Board of the Town of Newton has, by adoption of this Ordinance, confirmed the specific statutory authority, powers and duties noted in the specific sections of this ordinance and has established by these sections and this ordinance, the regulations, controls and enforcement against certain uses, activities, businesses and operations by persons that may affect the traffic in the Town of Newton.

Except as specifically noted otherwise in this ordinance, in chapter 340 to 349 (1988-1989) Wis. Stats., inclusive, Chapter 350 and Chapter 941, (1988-1989) Wis. Stats., describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles, traffic and snowmobiles for which the penalty is a forfeiture only, including penalties to be imposed and procedure for prosecution, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference by the town of Newton and made part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

Any future amendments, modifications, revisions, additions or deletions of the above noted statutory chapters shall be incorporated herein and made part of this ordinance in order to secure uniform state regulations of traffic on the public highways, roads, streets and alleys of the State of Wisconsin.
