

TOWN BOARD MEETING  
May 11, 2026, at 10:00 AM

Meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM

Attending the meeting were Chair Denise Thomas, Supervisor Kevin Behnke, Supervisor Ed Downing, Road Supervisor Dave Mueller

Pledge of Allegiance was recited

Verification of posting-affidavit on file.

Devin from Keller was discussing the cost of a cistern for the fire house project and a motion was made to move forward with the cistern by Supervisor Behnke and seconded by Supervisor Downing, motion carried. The board then walked over to the job site and approved the brick for the outside of the new building.

Brian Broeckmann from Family Insurance Center, addressed the board with any updates the board had on the coverage the town will need for insurance for the upcoming renewal year. A few updates were needed on their end to get the quotes needed for the renewal which is up on July 1, 2026. Brian will have the renewal pricing for our June board meeting.

Cedar Corporation was awarded the contract to monitor the wells on the landfill site on Newton Road. Two bids were received from Cedar Corporation for \$4,700.00 and Robert E. Lee for \$5950.00. Motion was made by Supervisor Behnke, to go with Cedar Corporation for the testing, seconded by Supervisor Downing, motion carried.

Road work for this year was discussed. Bids will be accepted for S 26<sup>th</sup> Street and Applewood/Rolling Hills with cold mix wedging and single seal coat using 3/8 black granite, Lambert Lane and Law Lane will be full cold mix 1 1/2 inch over lay. Bids will be opened on June 10, 2026, at the Town Board Meeting. Silver Creek Road at train tracks will be addressed. A few other road projects and culvert repairs will be done this year; all staying within the road budget we have.

Motion was made by Supervisor Behnke and second by Supervisor Downing to adjourn at 11:30 AM. Motion carried unanimously.
